Activities Since October 2007 State Conference

1. Updated FSMTA database as members reported changes in contact information and as MTNA sent monthly membership renewal reports
2. Sent interim webmaster Amy Turon new member information and changes in contact information of current members to keep the membership list in the FSMTA directory on the website updated

5. Corresponded with local membership chairs about prospective members and answered questions regarding membership issues

7. Provided a bimonthly mailing list (labels) to Modern Mailers for newsletters
8. Corresponded with Elaine Donaldson and Johnfrancis Twomey in the MTNA membership department concerning membership issues
9. Provided information to Tanya Brooks, Provisional Member Chair, when needed
10. Provided information to Charles Turon, College Council chair, when needed
11. Provided information to current and prospective collegiate chapter sponsors when needed
12. Sold 846 labels (\$84.60) to St. Petersburg College for music department mailing; Sent check from SPC to Treasurer Albert Rozier

Since the FSMTA directory is now on the website, I am no longer mailing hard copies to new members. New student members are being sent a letter welcoming them to FSMTA and referring them to both the directory and the newsletter on-line at a cost of \$.41 per letter. Other new members are being sent a hard copy of the last issue of the newsletter along with the welcome letter at a cost of \$.58 per mailing. Sending the directory along with the other information cost more than three times as much, so this change will result in significant savings to the association.
