As reported at the Board meeting in November, many activities as College Council Chair centered on assisting with the FSMTA Conference in Bradenton. This included serving as College Liaison for the Conference and soliciting eight college faculty members of the College Council who made presentations/workshops at the conference.

I also attended the MTNA Conference in Milwaukee in March, 2011. While at the conference I attended the Collegiate Faculty Forum, the Collegiate Chapters Forum, and the Wellness Forum. Discussion topics at the College Faculty Forum included starting up new collegiate chapters and the value of certification for college faculty. Several ideas were presented that may impact future conferences, such as coordinating the College Faculty Forum with the Collegiate Chapters Forum so that they would either be held collectively or overlap with each other. Many ideas were also shared at the Collegiate Chapters Forum, with breakout groups discussing the following areas: business, communication, the national conference, finances, outreach, recruiting, and the future of collegiate chapters in MTNA. A large number of student members attended the collegiate chapters forum, including five members from the State College of Florida chapter.
