The 2011 Florida MTNA Competitions will take place at Daytona State College of Florida, Daytona, on Saturday, November 5th, 2011. Rehearsals will take place on Friday, November 4th. Contestants will be performing in the beautiful Performing Arts Building on the campus.

Competitive categories include Strings, Brass, Woodwind, Piano Solo, Piano Duet, Voice, Chamber Music Performance, and Composition.
