4. Forwarded newsletters to members due to address printing errors from printer.
5. Updated the FSMTA database from monthly MTNA membership renewal reports.
6. Updated FSMTA database as members reported changes in contact information.
7. Updated e-mail list for those members opting to receive the FSMTA newsletter online.
8. Processed new member applications, updated the FSMTA database, mailed "welcome" packets, and forwarded new applicant dues and MTNA applications to Treasurer, Albert Rozier.
9. Answered e-mail and telephone questions about FSMTA membership and referred prospective members to the appropriate Local Membership Chair when applicable.
10. Answered e-mail and telephone questions from District and Local Presidents regarding membership information.
11. Corresponded with Local Membership Chairs about prospective and new members and application procedures, including the raise in MTNA dues, and the updated 2011/2012 Membership Handbook and applications.
12. Compiled lists of members in each local MTA who had NOT renewed their membership by the end of September, and sent that along with an "Exit Survey" to each local Membership Chair for follow-up.

16. Provided information to Charles Turon, College Council Chair.

18. Sold 857 (\$85.70) labels on 7/23/10 to FSU School of Music for Publicity Purposes
19. Sold 747 labels (\$74.70) on 11/8/10 to St. Petersburg College for Publicity Purposes.
20. Sold 582 labels (\$58.20) on 12/3/10 to John Fischer, Executive Director for Artist Series of Sarasota, for publicity purposes. (They wanted only those teachers who listed "piano" as their primary teaching field)
21. Sold 763 labels (\$76.30) on 12/7/10 to FSU School of Music for Publicity Purposes
22. Contacted local Membership Chairs to encourage them to participate in MTNA's "Each One, Reach One" campaign.

There are twenty-one provisional members at this time. Three provisional members achieved Active status, two did not renew their membership, three are close to their expiration dates, one moved. Each provisional member needs to send original student tests to me to be put in that provisional member's folder. Each local association has the responsibility of mentoring that member to encourage the provisional member to complete Student Day requirements and to take the Provisional Membership test.
