

State Conference Committees

General duties:

(From Article XV, Sections 1- 8 Conferences)

- The FSMTA President-Elect shall serve as State Chair for Annual Conference and the chairs of the past two conferences shall serve in an advisory capacity.
- Conference committees shall be appointed by the President(s) of the Host District(s) and the Conference Chair (President Elect).
- The location of the Conference shall be rotated around the state according to Districts as determined by the Executive Board.
- The person designated to be the Conference Guest Artist shall be approved by the Executive Board.
- All non-affiliated persons who wish to attend the annual Conference may do so by paying a special non-member registration fee.
- Students performing on Conference programs shall not be assessed a registration fee for the event(s) in which they participate. However, they must pay the appropriate registration fee(s) as established for the conference to attend other events. This Bylaw does not apply to participants in any of the student auditions or competitions.
- Parents, other relatives, and chaperones will be permitted to attend student recitals and auditions open to registrants without fee. They shall be given a badge showing GUEST OF STUDENT. However, upon payment of the registration fee they may attend any other Conference events.
- Members in good standing from other State Music Teachers Associations may attend conferences of this Association upon payment of the member registration fee.
